Can he live again to make his dream come true? Can the new soul (named 23) find their place in the world. A heartwarming film about the choices we make in life and how we need to make best decisions we can.

Tenet—A high idea action adventure film. Someone has found the ability to operate backwards in time. A protagonist (as his is known) must stop a Russian oligarch from using this power to damage the future. This is very whibbly-wobbly-timey-wimey. It is great idea and it is shot beautifully. The protagonist is not given the depth he deserves and that is problematic.




